### What activities are included and what this BIP will bring you?

1. You will work in an international team with students in Pharmacy from CEU San Pablo Madrid, Turin and Joanneum Universities to conduct interviews with professionals working in various countries in sectors related to your degree. In this way, you will know first-hand the professional opportunities in the field of Pharmacy, Biotechnology and/or Nutrition, being able to compare their development in different countries. You do not need to look for the professionals, a list of contacts will be given to each team.
2. You will interact personally with relevant professionals in each sector of your profession who can be mentors to guide you in your professional future.
3. You will participate in an International Congress in which you will present with your team an oral communication on a professional outing. In addition, this Congress will include the following activities:
  - Plenary conferences
  - Roundtables on entrepreneurship, leadership and innovation
4. You will obtain a certificate of participation.
5. 15 students can participate to the first part of the program, including 8 students who will be able to participate to the activities organized in Paris from the 6<sup>th</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup> of July 2026. This will be an opportunity to visit institutions and companies in and around Paris where you can develop your professional career. You will increase your network.
